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## 1. QUICK SETUP

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- Install **Gravity Forms** (not included in this plugin)
- Upload and Activate the „**Gravity Forms - List & Edit**“ Plugin
- Setup the Form Settings at the Gravity-Forms Settings Page
- Setup the Field Settings for each Form-Field that should be displayed at the Advanced-Settings
- Include the 'Gravitylist' Shortcode at your content

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## 2. UPLOAD AND ACTIVATE

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### 2.1. UPLOAD


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After you downloaded and saved the 'Gravvy Forms - List & Edit' Plugin you have to upload it to your wordpress installation.

Please go to you 'Plugins/Add New' Menu, select 'Upload' from the top links and choose the downloaded ZIP-File at the upload-field.

After selecting the File please press the „Install Now“ Button.

If you have a plugin in a .zip format, you may install it by uploading it here.

## 2.3. UPDATING THE PLUGIN

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If you updated the plugin from a release lesser than 2.0 you have to re-save all the settings.

### 3. SETUP YOUR FIELD SETTINGS FOR THE ENTRY-LIST

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#### 3.1. FIELD SETTINGS

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For each field you want to display in your DataTable, you can define the position at the Gravity-Forms Field-Settings.

At the bottom you could select the number of the position for each field.

### 3.2. SETUP THE GENERAL SETTINGS

For each Form you could define the general Settings at the default Gravity-Forms Settings Tab.

**Gravity List**

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Show records to  To wich users to entries should be displayed

Enable Paging  Enable the Paging-Mode at the DataTable

Enable ordering  Enable the Ordering-Mode at the DataTable

Enable Searching  Enable the Search-Box at the DataTable

Preferred Data Source  Wich Data-Source do you prefer to build the list.

<b>Show records to</b>	Define who is allowed to see the Records : all - All users can see the records logged in - Only logged-in users can see the records entry creator - Only the user who created an entry can see his own entries only to the admin - Only an admin-user ca see the records
<b>Enable Paging</b>	Enable the Paging feature at the DataTable. At the Selectbox you can select the default number of records to display.
<b>Enable Sorting</b>	Enable the Forting feature at the DataTable
<b>Enable Searching</b>	Enable the search-box and feature at the DataTable




## 4. INCLUDE THE GRAVITYLIST SHORTCODE AT YOUR POSTS OR PAGES

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To display the Datable you have to add the 'gravitylist' shortcode at your posts, pages or custom post types.

The easiest way is to add a default Gravity-Forms shortcode with the 'add form' button



At the Gravity-Forms dialog you could select the needed form

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
## 5. SETTING UP THE PLUGIN FEATURES

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### 5.1. ADDITIONAL SETUP FEATURES

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At the Form-Settings you have some additional Settings to Control the display of your Entries. Please go to the Form-Settings-Tab of Gravity-Forms.



At the Bottom you'll find the new Settings of the „Gravity-Forms - List & Edit“ Plugin.

**List & Edit Settings**

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Enable AddNew Button  Enable a text or an icon button to add a record.

Enable Change Button  Enable a text or an icon button to change a record.

Enable Delete Button  Enable a text or an icon button to delete a record.

Records workable by  From wich users to entries should be workable

Page to the gfEdit destination

<i>Field</i>	<i>Description</i>
<b>Enable AddNew Button</b>	Define if you need to display an 'AddNew' link and if this should be a text-button or an image-button
<b>Enable Change Button</b>	Define if you need to display an 'Change' link and if this should be a text-button or an image-button.
<b>Enable Delete Button</b>	Define if you need to display an 'Delete' link and if this should be a text-button or an image-button.
<b>Records workable by</b>	Define who is allowed to work at the records : all - All users can work with the records logged in - Only logged-in users can work with the records entry creator - Only the user who created an entry can work with his own entries only by the admin - Only an admin-user can work with the records
<b>Page to the gfeedit destination</b>	Here you could select the Wordpress-Page where the assigned Form will be displayed.

## 5.2. SETTING UP EVENT-DEFINIED CONFIRMATIONS

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At the Gravity-Forms Confirmation settings it's possible to add Event-Definied Confirmations. This Feature is only visible if you have more than 1 Confirmation enabled.
